11. **Annual Report of the college for the year 2006-07 :**

ANNUAL REPORT 2006-2007

The academic year 2005-06 has seen Ghulam Ahmed College of Education strive to develop in the students professional skills, crave for excellence and a positive outlook towards teaching. The college engaged in comprehensive reviewing and updating of the curriculum in both B.Ed., and M.Ed., courses. Efforts were made to strengthen the academic core and provide an interdisciplinary experience to the students.

The entire teacher education programme was woven round a framework of theory and practical work related to the field of education. Right from the onset of the course, the students were divided into small groups and they took up activities like paper presentations, craft work, preparation of teaching aids, conducting experiments in psychology etc.

The lecturers of the college were entrusted the responsibility of mentorship they had to monitor the overall progress of the students. Seven special projects were taken up in the B.Ed., course – 1. Community Studies Project, 2. Health and Physical Education Project, 3. Case Study Project, 4. School Study Project, 5. Cultural Studies and SUPW Project, 6. Computer Education Project and 7. Personality Development and Communicative English Project. The students either did the project individually or in a group. Different topics were assigned to different students to avoid repetition and copying. The students also took up a project on “Environment and its Care” under

National Green Corps {NGC} in December last year. After completing each project, the students were asked to 'show case' their findings.

Several multimedia presentations were prepared by the B.Ed. students with the help of Power Point, on computers. The projects prepared were on different subjects like Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, English Language, Social Studies and Biological Sciences.

The students were exposed to socially useful productive activities like preparation of hangers, gift bags, wooden toys, greeting cards, table mats, ceramic work, glass painting, making of files, folders, letter pads, book binding, etc.

Library was computerized. The students were encouraged to take up reference work in the library for their assignments and field experiences. There are a total of 7270 books and 42 journals in the library.

After a thorough practice of teaching skills in the college, the students were sent for their teaching practice programme and internship to different schools of twin cities in October - November, 2006 for 40 days.

The students of M.Ed., did research on selected topics from different areas of education, under the guidance of the college lecturers. The students were exposed to computerized statistical procedures for analyzing and interpreting the data.

A college magazine "Edu-Vision-2007" was brought out by the students of B.Ed., and M.Ed., courses.

EXTENSION LECTURES/SEMINARS/WORK SHOPS ORGANISED :

The following extension lectures and seminars were organized in the college to enable the students and teachers to keep themselves abreast of the latest developments in the field of education.

1. An extension lecture on "Study Circle..... a step towards human excellence" by Prof.Suresh Parikh, Chairperson, Board of Studies, Department Psychology, Osmania University on 26.6.2006.
2. An extension lecture on "Career prospects for Teachers" by Mr.Syed Arif on 13.7.2006.
3. "Use of Experiments while teaching Physical Science", an extension lecture delivered by Mr.Shakeel, Head, Department of Physics in October, 2006.
4. Extension lecture on "Environmental Education" by Ms.Indira Sampath, Project Officer, N.G.C., Department of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology, on 15th September, 2006.
5. A Work Shop on "Instructional Objectives" was conducted for students of the B.Ed., course in August, 2006.
6. A Work Shop on "Preparation of Teaching aids" was conducted for students of the B.Ed., course in October, 2006.

7. "Personality Development Programme" was organised by the S.I.L., {School for Integrated Learning} for the B.Ed., students of the college. The sessions were conducted thrice a week by Mr.Shehbaz Ahmed and his team of resource persons.
8. A Seminar on the theme "Know your Profession" was organized in July, 2006. Prof.Jagan Mohan delivered the Keynote address. Lecturers of the college and students presented papers.
9. Lecture on "Job opportunities for Teachers, in India and Abroad" by Mr.Zuber Hussain from Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan on 14.9.2006.

Extra-curricular Activities :

A number of extra curricular activities were organized for the students.

1. Literary activities like elocution, debate, extempore talk and recitation competitions were organized.
2. Competitions were organized in the effective use of Black Board; use of teaching aids; patriotic songs; naath; mehendi competition and use of Projected Aids.
3. Students were given practice in singing of National Anthem and National songs.
4. A field trip to National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped [NIMH] was organized for students of B.Ed., & M.Ed., course in August last year. The students went for an excursion to Pragathi Resorts in January, 2007.

Results : The results of the B.Ed., course were exceptionally good. The details of the results are as follows :

3. College Day was celebrated on 24th January, 2007. Mr.Khan Lateef Mohd.Khan, Chairman, SES, was the Chief Guest of the function.

4. A College Magazine – Edu-vision-2007 was brought out by the college students and it was released on the college day function.
5. A few teaching aids prepared by the B.Ed. students were distributed to the schools where the teaching practice programme was conducted.
6. An Orientation programme for teachers of Sultan-Ul-Public Schools, was taken up by the college lecturers last year.

FACULTY ACCOMPLISHMENTS :

The atmosphere in the college is that of evolution and not of stagnation. The staff members are constantly upgrading their qualifications and in the process winning laurels for themselves and the college.

- Mr.K.N.Krishna Kumar qualified in the NET examination in Education conducted by U.G.C.

Dr.Najma Unnisa Mrs.Vaseem Banu, Dr.P.Vijayalaxmi, Dr.Ch.Chandra Sekhar, and published articles in reputed Educational Journals/Newspapers. Dr.Najma Unnisa, Dr.Ch.Chandra Sekhar, Mr.K.N.Krishna Kumar and Mr.Sana Ahmed attended a three week Orientation programme at Academic Staff College, Osmania University in March, 2006.
- Almost all the lecturers delivered lectures at various workshops and Seminars conducted by different institutions.
- The Principal and lecturers attended orientation programmes, seminars and workshops in Education. They acted as Chairperson/Members of the Moderation Board for checking the practical work of different colleges.
